Class/Division Eligibility

LEADLINE riders are 5-7 years old as of 1/1/14 and eligible for only the Leadline Division.

WALK-TROT riders are 8-18 years old as of 1/1/14 and eligible for only the Walk-Trot Division.

JUNIOR English riders are 8-13 years old as of 1/1/14.

SENIOR English riders are 14-18 years old as of 1/1/14.

ADULT riders are 19 years & older as of 1/1/14.

WESTERN riders are all riders 8-18 years old (Juniors and Seniors combined).

If your horse has little-to-no show experience, you are eligible for the **GREEN HORSE** and Gymkhana Divisions.

4-H DIVISION is open to all registered 4-H Members and their 4-H Projects (must be registered as of 6/19/14)

Rules and Regulations

1. Animals who tend to kick must wear a red ribbon on tail.
2. Horses must be in complete control before entering and leaving the ring. Horses must be kept at a walk outside the show ring, except in the designated practice areas.
3. Safety is our first priority. Unruly horses or people will be asked to leave the show grounds without refund.
4. Please keep dogs in the spectator area on the hill or at your trailer and away from the horses in the ring waiting area.
3. Show committee reserves the right to dismiss any horses that appear to be lame or sick.
4. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the fairgrounds.
5. ASTM Approved helmets must be worn by all participants 19 and under as of 1/1/2014 and all riders must wear hard soled shoes with a heel (small equine, see Small Equine Division Rules below).
6. Participants are responsible for their own property. Littleton Hack & Tack shall not be held responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property.
7. This horse show is being run under the rules of the Massachusetts's 4-H Horse Show Rule Book.
8. Refunds are not given unless bona fide injury to horse or rider.
9. Stallions are not permitted at this show.
10. Current negative Coggins required for all horses. Name and description must match on all paperwork.
11. Show committee reserves the right to combine or cancel classes or change class order, if needed.
12. Patterns will be posted for Trail and all jumping classes.
13. Riders adding classes must do so 2 classes in advance to allow time to process entries. There will be two stable calls prior to each class; class will be closed two minutes after final call.

Driving Directions

Middlesex County 4-H Fairgrounds, Westford, MA (Route 110):

From Gardner Area: 2E to 495N to Exit 32 Westford/Boston Road (to Route 225). Off exit, take right. At lights, turn left. After Market Basket (on right), take right on South Chelmsford Road. Fairgrounds are 1 mile on right.

From Boston Area: 495S to Exit 32. Take left off exit. See above.

From Springfield Area: Take Mass Pike to Exit 11A (I-495) towards NH/Maine/Cape Cod. Keep left at fork in ramp and merge into 495N. Off exit, take right. At lights, turn left. After Market Basket (on right), take right on South Chelmsford Road. Fairgrounds are 1 mile on right.
Standing stalls are available on first come, first served basis.
